Advantage Multi for Dogs, a once-a-month topical imidacloprid + moxidectin solution for the prevention of heartworm disease (caused by *Dirofilaria immitis*) and the killing of adult fleas (*Ctenocephalides felis*), is indicated for treatment of flea infestations, as well as treatment and control of intestinal parasite infections; hookworms (*Ancylostoma caninum*, *Uncinaria stenocephala*); roundworms (*Toxocara canis*, *Toxascaris leonina*); and whipworms (*Trichuris vulpis*), in dogs that are at least 7 weeks of age and weigh at least 3 lbs.

Bayer Animal Health understands the importance of protecting the health of your pets. To show our confidence in the heartworm, hookworm, roundworm and whipworm protection of *Advantage Multi for Dogs* we are offering a dual-level guarantee for the management of heartworm infection and/or clinical intestinal nematode infection.

Prior to therapy, the veterinarian must contact Bayer Animal Health's Veterinary Technical Services at (800) 422-9874.

Level 1: Dogs that have received treatments of *Advantage Multi for Dogs* in adherence with the Companion Animal Parasite Council (CAPC), year-round (12 consecutive months), heartworm recommendations are as follows:

- Puppies that started between 7 weeks to 4 months of age, or
- Puppies that started treatments between 4 to 6 months of age with a negative antigen test 4 months later, or
- Dogs over 6 months of age with a negative antigen test at initiation of treatment and 4 months later, or
- If a dog is moved to *Advantage Multi for Dogs*, and away from another brand of heartworm preventative, a negative heartworm confirmation within the last 12 months and adequate purchase history of another brand of heartworm preventative must be on file prior to the start of *Advantage Multi for Dogs* heartworm preventative.

Diagnosis of heartworm infection following the start of preventative treatment must be confirmed by a second antigen test on a separate blood sample, which must be completed by an independent lab.* If after 12 months of continuous treatment, having met the above requirements and having received a positive heartworm antigen test, Bayer Animal Health will support up to \$1,000 for diagnostics and therapeutic treatment of the pet.* If, after 4 months of consecutive treatment with *Advantage Multi for Dogs*, the attending veterinarian diagnoses "clinical disease" resulting from intestinal parasite infection with hookworms (*Ancylostoma caninum*, *Uncinaria stenocephala*), roundworms (*Toxocara canis*, *Toxascaris leonina*), and whipworms (*Trichuris vulpis*), Bayer will support the clinic with appropriate treatment of the dog. Prior to therapy, the veterinarian must contact Bayer Animal Health's Veterinary Technical Services at (800) 422-9874.

Level 2: Limited to a dog that receives appropriate seasonal treatment of *Advantage Multi for Dogs* (a minimum of 5 consecutive months of treatment following the initial application, or 6 months total) and/or has an insufficient negative heartworm antigen test history (see above level) from initiation of product use for that particular 6-month period.* If 5 or more months after initiation of treatment the dog has a positive heartworm antigen test, the test must be confirmed with a second antigen test. Based on confirmation of results, Bayer Animal Health will then support up to \$500 for diagnostics and therapeutic treatment of the pet.* We specify the appropriate season.

* Infection must be confirmed by a second independent test using a different blood sample. Before additional independent testing is performed, the attending veterinarian must contact Bayer Animal Health's Veterinary Technical Services at (800) 422-9874. All support must be properly invoiced by the veterinarian providing services before support can be paid.
