Let's work out a complete package of preventative health care for _____, born on _____.

By planning for appropriate vaccinations and a few preventative procedures you can lay a good foundation for many years to come. Even if always kept indoors, your pet can be exposed to viruses carried in the air, dust, or clothing. Vaccinations are inexpensive protection against costly treatment or the premature death of your pet. An annual vaccine needs assessment can maintain this protection.

Our Treatment Plan for kittens includes physical examinations and all necessary distemper and upper respiratory vaccines, feline leukemia blood tests and vaccines, fecal sample testing (to determine the presence of intestinal parasites), proper worming medication, and rabies vaccines.

During your first visit our doctor will perform a complete physical examination of your kitten. After we review whatever previous care your kitten has received, we can help you set your goals for _____'s first year of health. Special assessment for kittens with outdoor/uncertain environment exposure will be included as well.
