Vaccinations are inexpensive protection against costly treatment or the premature death of your pet. An annual vaccine needs assessment can maintain this protection.

Our Treatment Plan for puppies includes physical examinations and all necessary distemper, hepatitis, parvo, parainfluenza vaccines, fecal sample testing (to determine the presence of intestinal parasites), proper worming medication, and rabies vaccine.

During your first visit our doctor will perform a complete physical examination of your puppy. After we review whatever previous care your puppy has received, we can help you set your goals for \_\_\_\_\_'s first year of health. Special assessment for puppies with uncertain environment exposure will be included as well.
